

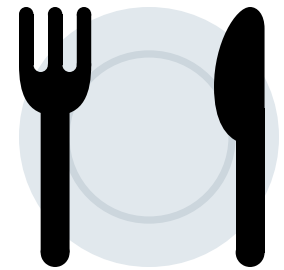
APPLY FOR A DISCHARGE PERMIT OR RENEW YOUR CURRENT PERMIT ONLINE!

The Public Sewer Discharge Permit is a requirement for all trading premises such as hotels, restaurants, factories, warehouses, hospitals, farms etc.
